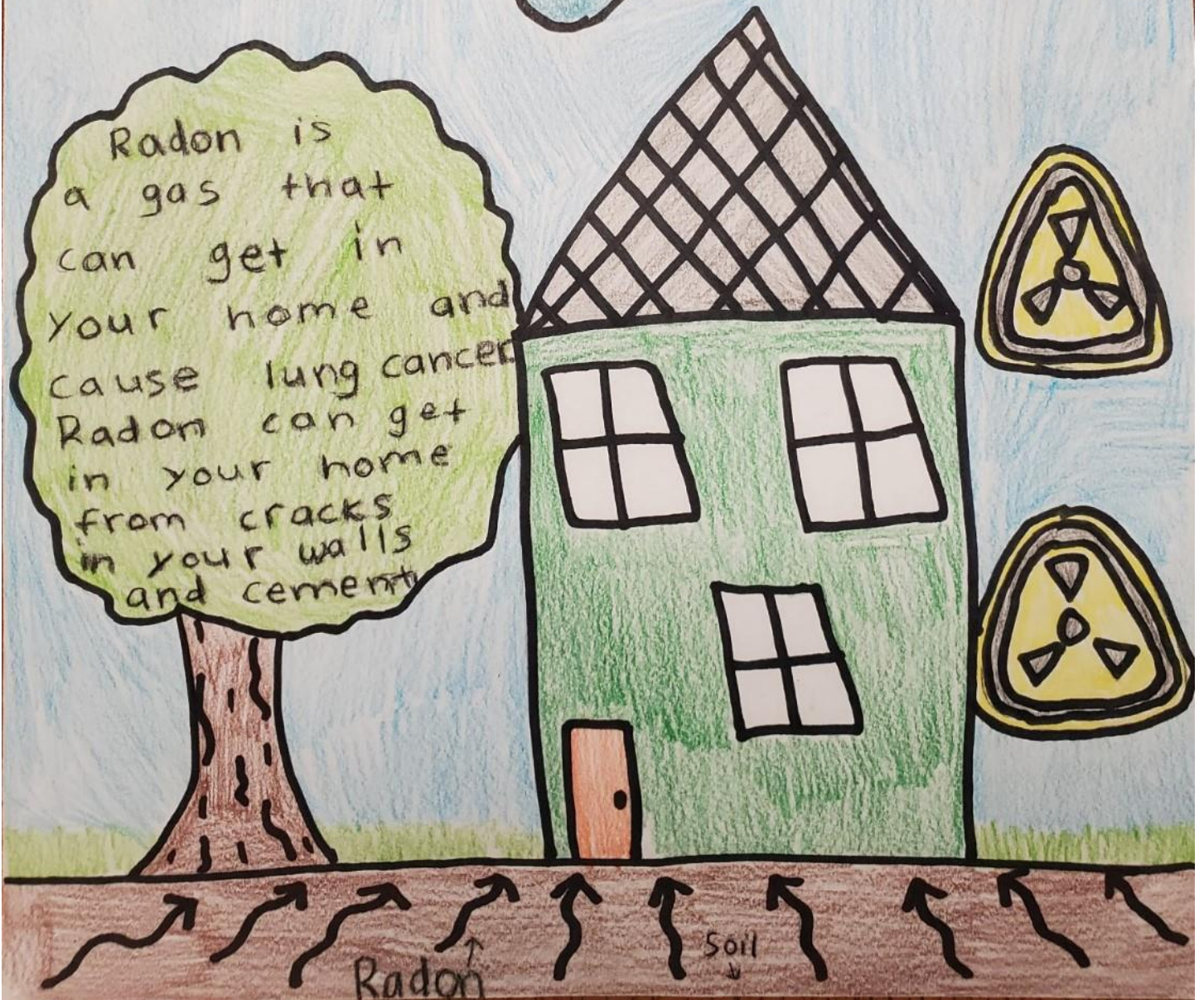

What is Radon?

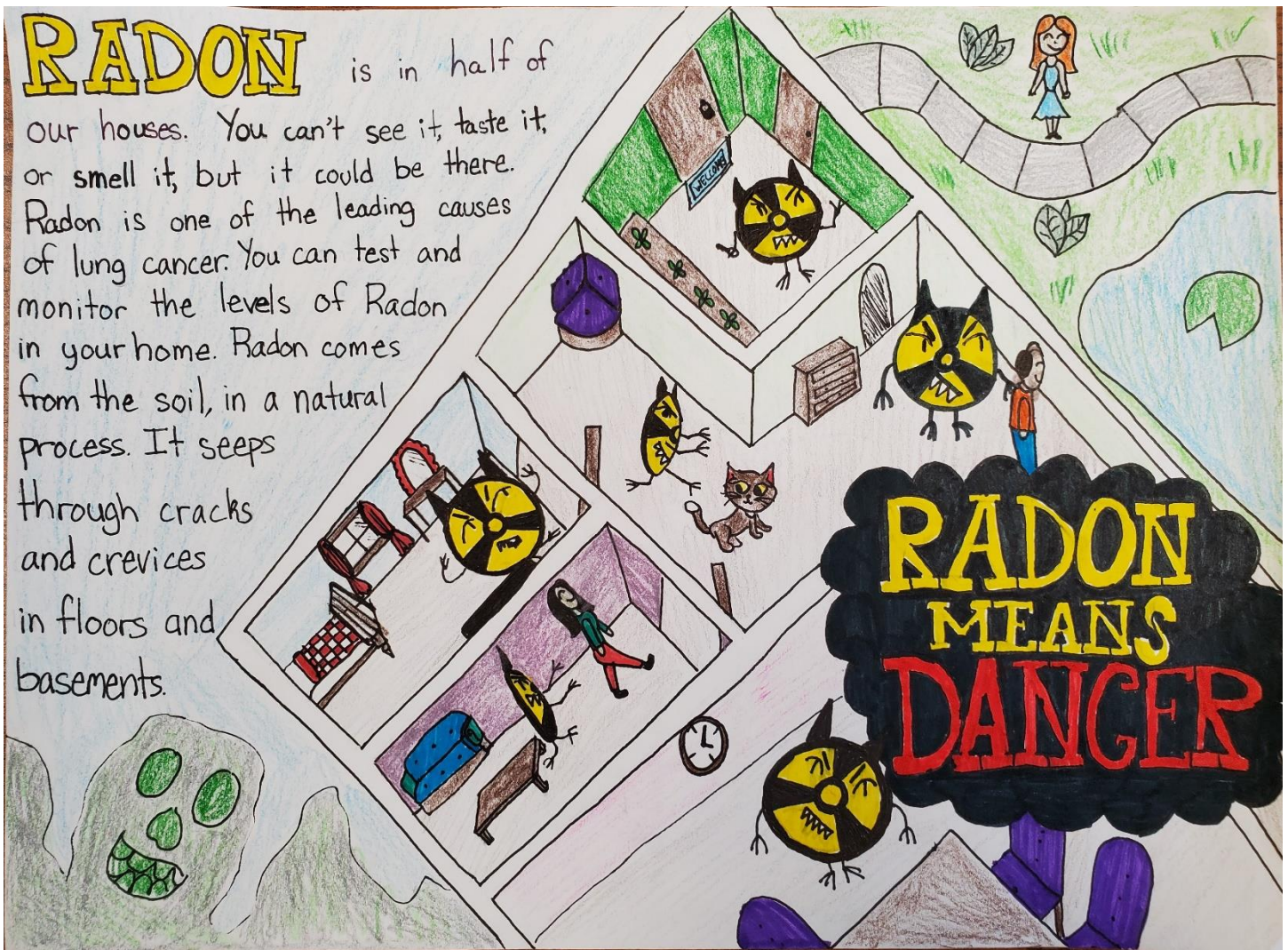
You can buy a Radon test to test your home.

Radon is a gas that can get in your home and cause lung cancer. Radon can get in your home from cracks in your walls and cement.

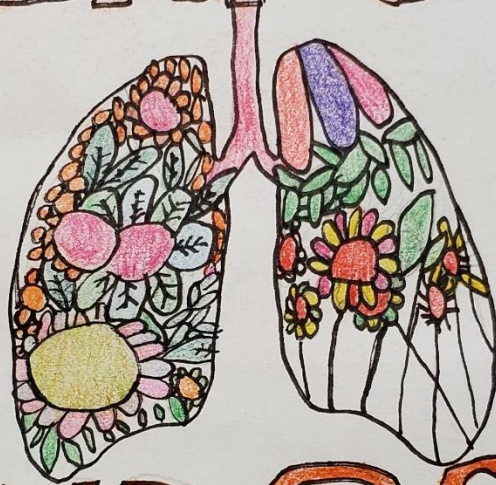

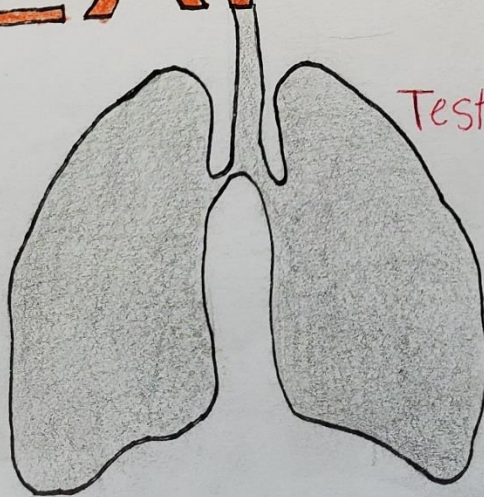
